In formulae Latin letters and Greek lowercase letters should be written in italics while Greek capital letters upright. Alignment is central. The paper should not end with an illustration or a table. 	
Thesis length	From 3 to 5 pages (1 page = 1800 characters without spaces, the number of pages is rounded up to a whole number)	
Percentage of the text originality	80%	
Additional	There is no page numbering. Only units, abbreviations, symbols accepted in the international system of measures, physical, chemical and mathematical quantities and terms can be used. In the paper only printing quotes (« ») should be used. Shortenings and abbreviations should be the same throughout the text.
